

MKINL 2021/22 Court Etiquette Procedure

For the coming season, the following protocols should be observed:

Persons allowed within the sports hall itself during the course of all matches:

- Players from both teams at their benches, teams are allowed up to 12 people in the sports hall per match.
- Officiators for the specific fixtures.
- Other Officiators plus mentors for officiating qualification purposes.
- Duty members.
- Any MKINL Committee members.

Everyone (except on-court players, umpires and duty personnel) <u>must</u> be seated at all times.

Duty personnel must manage the comings and goings of those allowed in sports hall.

Should others enter the court, the duty personnel must enquire why they are there and if not authorised must ask them to wait outside the sports hall.

The netball court should only be used by MKINL members and should be cleared of supporters during quarter or half time.

Subsequent match teams and their associates <u>should not enter the sports hall until the current match is finished</u>. However, a member of each of the waiting teams should approach the duty members in the sports halls in order to complete the administrative tasks necessary ahead of their match.

In venues where you need to walk past the netball court to access a suitable waiting area whilst a match is taking place, you must do so whilst the ball is in play at the other end of the court so as not to impede players/umpires or wait for quarter time whistle to be called.

PLEASE CAN ALL TEAMS ENSURE THEY EXIT THE SPORTS HALL PROMPTLY AT THE END OF THEIR OWN FIXTURE.
