- 6. Ideally would like the Divisions to be as follows; three divisions containing 12 teams and one containing 13
- 7. New teams- NU Amazon, Tickford Titans and Dragons likely to join Division 3, therefore making Division 3 13 teams strong.
- 8. The other new team LB2 could be assessed on Sunday 17th July. Suggestion made that it could occur on a Tuesday evening subject to other considerations.
- 9. 17/7/16 has been proposed as an assessment day, committee members to recruit opposition Panthers, Coopers, Storm, Titans and NU Aztecs. Outdoor courts booked at Hazeley 10-2pm
- 10. Year 7&8 taster day on the 17/07/16 to be cancelled due to lack of interest and courts to be used for assessment as an alternative
- 11. A committee member mentioned that Netters Ice would like to be promoted, no formal request to be assessed they are to be left on Division 2 for the upcoming season at this time
- 12. LB2 to either join Division 1 or 2 and this will require a shift of teams to gain the ideal number of teams in each division, those teams that have been demoted could potentially be promoted, e.g. Time Systems to move from Division 1 to Premier Division or LB Comets to move from Division 2 to Division 1 dependant on the assessment of LB2 and what division they get placed into
- 13. Potential new venues- Walton High Brooklands new campus with leisure centre. Lynne currently in communications with staff at Walton High. Tattenhoe Park new leisure centre to be built in the next 12-18 months and this could potentially be another new venue for future seasons
- 14. The extension of next season September 2016 to June 2017 will cost £300 more that the last season
- 15. Vote for venue and league changes For: 6, Abstained: 1 and Against: 0
- 16. Lynne to extend bookings from May to June 2017 to accommodate league changes
- 17. Emails sent to ask teams for any special requirements

- 18. Katrina to investigate the new Radcliffe school sports hall- entrance and parking etc.
- Duty boxes- new boxes suggested by one committee member and other options also presented by others- Metal boxes vs. Plastic boxes (significant price difference) Vote- Unanimous for plastic boxes

LFJ to forward TI details of plastic boxes for her to purchase as she had the information to hand.

- 20. Duty pads- ordering 6 new ones each with 50 sheets (independently sourced by duty secretary) tbc
- 21. Clarification needed to be written into duty protocol regarding where umpires details are written on the duty pad
- 22. Envelopes to be provided- LFJ to source from work however if not successful to be independently sourced by duty secretary tbc
- 23. Stamps and labels to be purchased by duty secretary tbc
- 24. Score boards- enough for season venues and 1 spare
- 25. Enough timers and bells in duty boxes but each box will now require 2 timers or 1 timer and a stopwatch as 30 injury time will be adopted though match time will not be stopped
- 26. Sara will provide score cards
- 27. Tina to confirm contents of duty boxes- and to make up one spare duty box
- 28. England Netball Rules: Injury time process
- 29. If these rules are implemented 6 new stop watches will need to be purchased for all duty boxes
- 30. Suspension for 2 minutes rule contained in the England netball rule book may be implemented by umpires if they see fit as the league's rules are supplementary to England netball rules... this relates to C awards and above
- 31. Secretary reads out emails- teams asking for early games and certain duty venues as well as interest from new players etc.
