Guidelines to the Fair Play Award

The Fair Play Award is to assist teams in awarding opposing teams who have:

- 5 <u>Consistent</u> good manner, good play, good timing, acceptance of decisions, courteous, display good sportsmanship
- 4 As above with the <u>occasional</u> mishaps such as raised eyebrows or comments.
- 3 Average play with <u>inconsistent</u> attitude, edging on a bit of aggravation but no major incidents
- 2 Frequent attitude, more bad than good play
- 1 Continuous bad attitude, bad sportsmanship, several warnings

Your team Captain will then provide this information to the Duty team on the night.

An award will be given out to <u>1 team in the league</u> who has the highest Fair Play Award score, this is a great recognition of good sportsmanship.

Guidelines to Player of the Match Award

Players of the Match are to be decided by the opposing team, based on these principles:

Consistent good manner

Good play

Acceptance of decisions

Courteous

Display good sportsmanship

Adhered to the MKINL & England Netball Code of Conduct

Your team Captain will then provide this information to the Duty team on the night.

These awards are given out to promote good sportsmanship amongst players and teams overall, without the players and teams there is no league, without the umpires there are no games.
